

Rules of the road

- You must wear a seatbelt when you are driving.
- You must always stop at a red light.
- Before moving off you should use all mirrors to check the road is clear
- Overtake only when it is safe and legal to do so.
- Do not overtake on the brow of a hill
- Avoid distractions when driving such as loud music
- You must not smoke in public transport vehicles.
- Once moving you should keep to the left
- Use mirrors frequently so you always know what's behind you.
- You should use Mirror-Signal-Manoeuvre at roundabouts
- You must not park on a crossing
- Do not reverse from a side road into a main road
- You must drive carefully and slowly in crowded shopping streets
- If you are following a large vehicle be aware that the driver may not be able to see you.
- You must use headlights when visibility is reduced
- You should drive at a slow speed and in a high gear when the roads are icy.
- You must not park on yellow lines.
- You must not park on the hard shoulder except in an emergency.
- Motorways must not be used for mobility scooters
- You must not exceed 70 mph on a motorway
