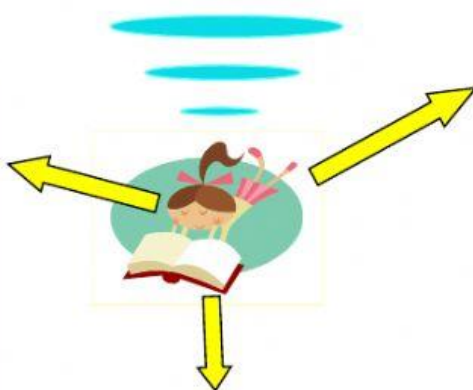


Yesterday, today or tomorrow?

PAST TENSE
Verbs in the past tense show action that already happened. Most verbs in the past tense end in -ed, but others are irregular.
Mark walked home.



FUTURE TENSE
Verbs in the future tense show action that are going to happen. Sometimes, they add will to show the future.
Mark is going to walk home.

PRESENT TENSE
Verbs in the present tense show action that happens every day. Most verbs in the present tense end in -s or -es.
Mark walks home.

Tense	Key words
Simple Present	Every day, every month, every week, every year Always, sometimes, never, often, usually, frequently Once a week, once a day, once a month, once a year
Simple Past	Yesterday Ago a year ago, years ago, a week ago weeks ago, months ago, days ago, hours ago In (past year); in 2019, in 1933 Last month, last week, last year, last century
Simple Future	Tomorrow, tonight, this month, this week, this afternoon, this year; someday In (future year, month, week); in a month, in a week, in two days on (future day) Saturday; next (month, week, year, name of day) Five days from now, three months from now, six weeks from now, two years from now
