

Reading Lesson

1. Read the conversation and draw lines from the names to each child.

EXAMPLE

MAN: Look at the children. What's the name of that dog opposite Charlie?

WOMAN: Oh. Its name's Bill. It's Charlie's dog.

MAN: And who's that boy between Charlie and Danny?

WOMAN: His name's Ed. He's Danny's brother.

MAN: Look. There's Clara. Who's that girl below her?

WOMAN: Below Clara? Oh, that's Sam. She's Clara's friend.

MAN: And who's the boy near Clara. Is it Joe?

WOMAN: Yes, that's right. Joe's near Clara.

MAN: Michael's here, too.

WOMAN: Yes. He's opposite Danny. Michael likes watching the big children.

MAN: And is that Liz? She's above Danny.

WOMAN: Yes, that's Liz above Danny. She's very clever!
