Saturn is a very big planet. It's about ten times bigger than Earth and it's about ten times further away from the sun than Earth. The gases that make Saturn are very, very cold, so the temperature is -180°C . It's much colder than anywhere on our planet and only Neptune is colder in our solar system. Saturn is famous for its thousands of beautiful rings, which are ice. We know a lot about Saturn because in 1979 a spacecraft, Pioneer 11, visited Saturn and took lots of photos. Saturn has got about 60 moons. This is more than any other planet.
