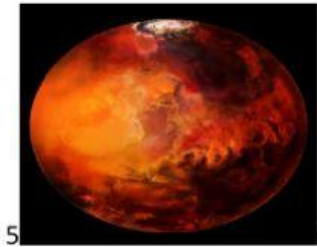


# 2020 SUMMER REVIEW
