Grammar focus:

Have got/ would like to

In English, some helping verbs like 'have' and 'would' are shortened when you speak.

Affirmative: I have/I've

Negative: 'I have got'/'I've got'

Example:

I've got a cold/cough/headache.

Form:

'I would like to'/'I'd like to'

Example:

'I'd like to change some money, please.'

Imperative

When we want to tell someone **to do something**, we use the **imperative** of a verb.

For example,

Take an aspirin. **Go** to bed.

When we want to tell someone **not to do something**, we use **don't + imperative** of a verb.

For example,

Don't drink too much coffee. **Don't go** to bed late.
