**Bye**

To say farewell, goodbye

**Cereal**

a plant that is grown to produce grain

**Cite**

to mention something as proof for a theory or as a reason for sth to happen

**Cellar**

a room under the ground floor of a building, usually used for storing things

**Coarse**

rough and not smooth or soft, or not in very small pieces:

**Dear**

loved or liked very much

**Doe**

the female of animals such as the deer or rabbit

**Fir**

a tall evergreen tree (= one that never loses its leaves) has needles, not leaves

**Flour**

powder made from grain, especially wheat, used for making bread, cakes, pasta...

**Genes**

parts of the DNA in a cell that control the physical development, behaviour, etc.

**Hear**

to receive or become conscious of a sound using your ears:

**Heal**

cure something (or somebody) sick, get better, return to health

**Buy**

to get something by paying money for it

**Serial**

a person who repeatedly commits a similar crime or carries out a similar bad act

**Site**

a place where something is, was, or will be built, or where something happened

**Seller**

a person who is selling something

**Course**

a set of classes or a plan of study on a particular subject (English with mpec!)

**Deer**

a quite large animal with four legs that eats grass and leaves.

**Dough**

flour mixed with water and often yeast, fat, or sugar, so that it is ready for baking

**Fur**

the thick hair that covers the bodies of some animals,

**Flower**

the part of a plant that is often brightly coloured and has a pleasant smell

**Jeans**

trousers made of denim (= strong blue cotton cloth) that are worn informally

**Here**

in, at, or to this place:

**Heel**

the rounded back part of the foot
