Tense	Uses	Affirmative	Negative	Interrogative
Past Simple	- To describe completed actions and situations - Past time expressions: <i>yesterday, last night/week...</i>	- Most regular verbs: we add -ed - Regular verbs ending <i>vowel</i> + <i>consonant</i> + <i>vowel</i>: we double the consonant and add -ed - Regular verbs ending <i>-e</i>: we add -d - Regular verbs ending <i>consonant</i> + <i>y</i>: we remove -y and add -ied <i>Irregular verbs have their own past</i>	We use the past of the verb do in its negative form and the verb in infinitive didn't + verb	We use the past of the verb do + subject + infinitive Did you play...?
