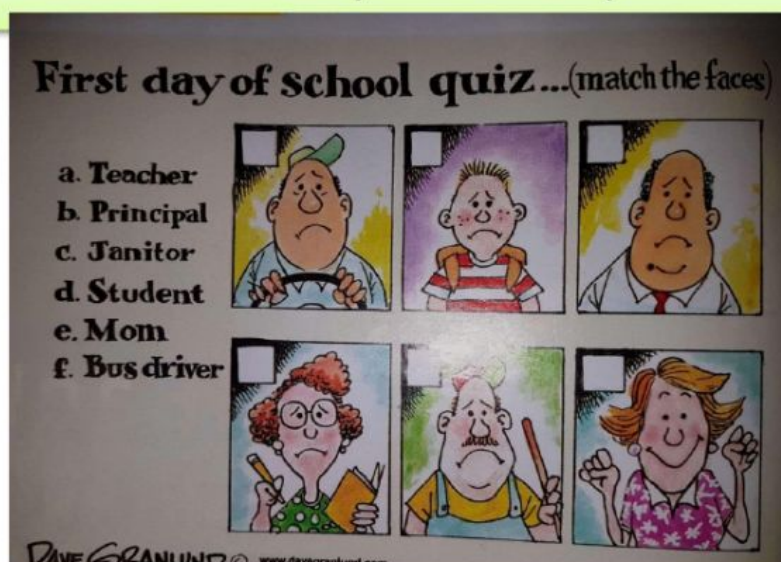


First day of school quiz.



The document is a postcard.

At the top of the postcard THERE **is** a title (which reads) "First day of school quiz".

So we know the document is (**both**) a postcard and a quiz.

On the left (=left handside) of the postcard, THERE **is** a list of names /roles or identities.

On the rest of the document THERE **are** six pictures of people (=characters/ faces)

We **must** match each role (identity) from the list on the left with their corresponding pictures **by** writing the letter before the identities, **in** the small squares (=boxes) **in the top left-hand corner** of the pictures.

I think the **first** person is the bus driver because he **is** driving.

(he **is** holding a driving wheel)

The **second** person **must** be the student (=pupil/schoolboy) because he has a backpack (=rucksack)

He doesn't look glad (= happy/pleased) to go back to school.

The **third** person is/seems to be the principal because he

is wearing a red tie and a white shirt.

We know the **fourth** person is the teacher because she has a pencil and a notebook.

The **fifth** person is /seems to be the janitor because he **is holding** a broomstick and he **is wearing** an overall .

The **sixth** person is (the only person who) **is smiling**

So, **we can guess** she is the mom . She is happy because her children **are finally going** back to school.
