 - She went back to sleep
 - She cried under her blankets
 - She got up and closed her window
- My principal walked past the third grade classroom. She could hear a lot of laughing coming from inside the room. What might have happened next?
 - The principal went inside the room to see what was so funny
 - The principal called the teacher on the phone
 - The teacher came out of the room crying
- Ron noticed a man on a ladder painting a building with white paint. A woman in a bright red suit walked under the ladder. What might have happened next?
 - He got paint on his suit
 - The woman got white paint on her red suit
 - He put on his sunglasses
