Aircraft Lighting Systems

Aircraft lighting systems provide¹ for both exterior and interior use. Lights on the exterior provide illumination for such operations as² at night, inspection of icing conditions, and safety from midair collision. Interior lighting provides illumination for instruments, cockpits, cabins, and other sections occupied by³ and passengers. Certain special lights, such as indicator and⁴ indicate the operation status of equipment.

Exterior Lights

Position, anticollision, landing, and⁵ lights are common examples of aircraft exterior lights. Some lights are required for night operations. Other types of⁶ such as wing inspection lights, are of great benefit for specialized flying⁷
