Areas that have a warm climate with a rainy season and a dry season.

The climate is ideal for the growth of grasses only because the few rains are enough for grasses but not enough for a forest of trees.

Animals are also prepared for fires, fleeing or burrowing underground to wait out the flames.

Its wildlife is famous in Africa, but this biome can also be found in South America, Asia, and Australia.

Most of the rain falls during just a few months of the year.

Large open areas of grass with very few trees.

Illegal hunting has resulted in the loss of many large animals, including elephants.

Frequent fires also maintain these ecosystems. Grasses are well adapted to grow back after a fire.
