

# GUESS THE TENSE!

We use **Present tense** to talk about things that happen right now or when something happens regularly.  
E.g., *I use my special pencil for English class.*

We use **Past tense** to talk about things that already happened.  
E.g., *I used my special pencil yesterday.*

 *Read the sentences. Write "present" if it is in present tense or "past" if it is in past tense. One has been done for you.*

- The bad dog was greedy, so he dropped the bone in the water. past
- The dog stayed in the farm's kitchen.
- Patch barked at the children.
- Patch is a very bad dog.

- The Fox loves cheese more than anything in the whole world.
- The Crow opened his beak and started to sing.
