## Arthropods

Arthropods have <u>six</u> or more legs.
They have an external skeleton called an <u>exoskeleton</u>. Insects, like an <u>ant</u>, have <u>six</u> legs.
Arachnichs, like <u>spiders</u>, have <u>eight</u> legs.
Crustaceans, like <u>crabs</u>, have <u>ten</u> legs.
Myriapods, like <u>millipedes</u> have <u>more</u> than 10.
They can live on <u>land</u>, in <u>water</u> and <u>fly</u>.
