

## ***El pretérito: Spelling changes***

In the PRETERITE, verbs ending in -car/-gar/-zar have spelling changes that take place ONLY in the “yo” form.

**sacar (c>qu)**

**pagar (g>gu)**

**empezar (z>c)**

Conjugate the following -car/-gar/-zar verbs in the preterite tense according to the subject.

In addition, most verbs that end in another vowel before the -er or -ir ending (-yó/-yeron). This change ONLY takes place in the third person (él, ella, Ud., ellos, ellas, Uds.)

Conjugate the following -yó/-yeron verbs in the preterite tense according to the subject.
