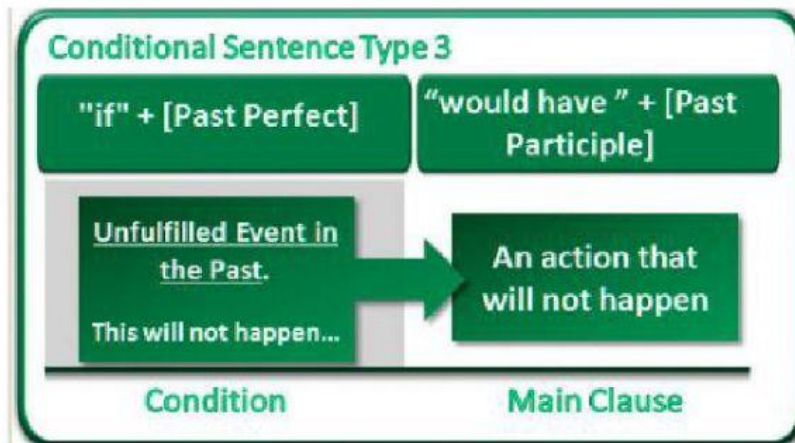


# Third Conditional
