Singular Possessive Nouns

- A singular possessive noun shows that one person, place, or thing has or owns something.
- Form a singular possessive noun by adding an apostrophe and *s* ('s) to a singular noun.

Singular Nouns

woman
Carlos
donkey

Singular Possessive Nouns

woman's horse
Carlos's watch
donkey's ears
