**Nerves**

| Part of Skin | Function  |
|--------------|---|
|              | Help regulate body temperature  |
|              | Muscles contract causing hairs to stand upright (goosebumps); this generates heat when body is cold.    |
|              | Secret sweat which travels up sweat ducts to sweat pores. Heat is lost when sweat evaporates from skin. |
|              | Detect changes in temperature, pressure and pain  |
|              | Secretes sebum which helps protect, soften, moisturize and hydrate the skin                             |
