Drag the Parts of the skin to its correct function

- Nerves
- Sebacaceous (oil) gland
- Hair erector muscles
- Arterioles & capillary network
- Sweat Glands

Part of Skin	Function
	Help regulate body temperature
	Muscles contract causing hairs to stand upright (goosebumps); this generates heat when body is cold.
	Secrete sweat which travels up sweat ducts to sweat pores. Heat is lost when sweat evaporates from skin.
	Detect changes in temperature, pressure and pain
	Secretes sebum which helps protect, soften, moisturize and hydrate the skin
