AFFIRMATIVE (+)

I drove a car. (irregular)

He walked to school. (regular)

NEGATIVE (-)

I didn't drive a car. (irregular)

He didn't walk to school. (regular)

QUESTION (?)

Did I drive a car?

Did he walk to school

VS

Past Continuous

AFFIRMATIVE (+)

We were dancing.

He was carrying a case.

NEGATIVE (-)

We weren't studying.

He wasn't holding a gun.

QUESTION (?)

Were they studying?

Was he holding a bar?
