

Months and Seasons

There are 4 seasons in a year: **spring, summer, autumn and winter**.
There are three months in a season.

Spring months are **March, April, and May**. Spring begins in March and is over in May. The weather in spring is cloudy, windy and warm. When spring is over, summer comes.

Summer months are **June, July and August**. Summer begins in June and is over in August. The weather in summer is warm or hot. There are thunders with showers. When summer is over, autumn comes.

Autumn months are **September, October, and November**. Autumn begins in September and is over in November. The weather is often rainy, windy, foggy and cool. When autumn is over, winter comes.

Winter months are **December, January, and February**. Winter begins in December and is over in February. The weather is snowy and cold.

Thirty days have September, April, June and November. All the rest have thirty-one, excepting February alone, which has twenty-eight days in **clear years** and twenty-nine in each **leap year**.

Every **month** has four **weeks** and some more **days**. Each week has seven days: five **working days** and two **week-end days**. The working days are **Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday**. The week-end days are **Saturday and Sunday**.

Each day has four **daytimes**. There are **morning** (4-10 o'clock), **afternoon**(11-17 o'clock), **evening**(18-22 o'clock) and **night** (23-3 o'clock).

Each day has **24 hours**, each hour has 60 **minutes**, each minute has 60 **seconds**.
