I don't like soccer. I don't like football. (alternative)

I don't like soccer **OR** football.

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I like exercise. I don't like team sports. (contrasting)

I like exercise **BUT** I don't like team sports.

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I love playing soccer. I like watching TV. (adding)

I love plying soccer **AND** watching TV.

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2. I like rock climbing. I like bird watching. (adding)

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3. I like heavy metal. I'm not a big fan. (contrasting)

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4. I love cooking. I hate cleaning the kitchen. (contrasting)

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5. I love skating. I love skateboarding. (adding)

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6. I love texting my friends. I love chatting on social media. (adding)

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7. I don't like doing homework. I don't like studying. (alternative)

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8. I don't like knitting. I don't like crocheting. (alternative)

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9. Do you like playing soccer? Do you like playing baseball? (alternative)

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10. Do you prefer indoor leisure activities? Do you prefer outdoor leisure activities? (alternative)

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
