b) using (NOT) AS + adjective + AS

Ex: Jenny's dress is not as _____ as Pam's.

c) LESS + adjective (the opposite of MOST+ adj)

We use the SUPERLATIVES to compare a thing or person with the rest of the group.

We use: _____ + superlative form of the adjective + (of all /in a place/ a clause with a Perfect Tense)

These adjectives have **IRREGULAR FORMS**: bad, good and _____
