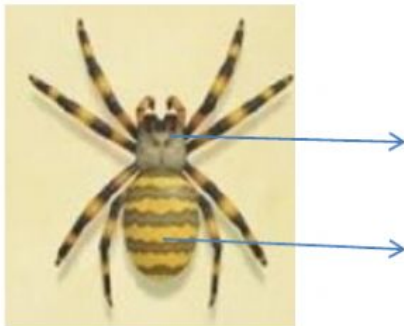


Natural Science Unit 1: Invertebrates
