Affirmative

I / HE / SHE/ IT	was	Mexican. in the studio.
YOU / WE / THEY	were	born in 1907.

Negative

I / HE / SHE/ IT	wasn't	French. in the office.
YOU / WE / THEY	weren't	born in London.
