## Direct to Reported Speech.

We can report what somebody says without needing to use speech marks. For example,

"I want to be a hero!" announced Elikem.

## becomes

Elikem announced that he wanted to be a hero.

- 1. You have to write reported speech in the past tense.
- 2. The word **that** is important.

"I like your tie!" commented Hamza. - becomes - Hamza commented that he liked my tie.
