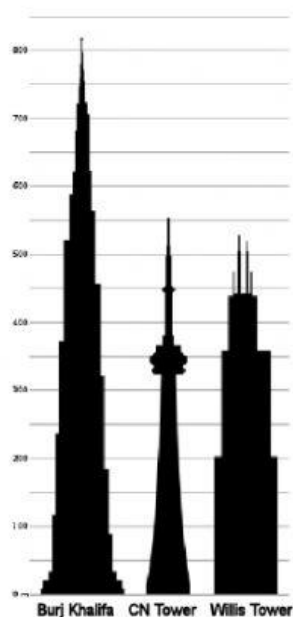


Work out the rule: Making comparisons

- 1- Look at the following diagram. Which building is the **tallest**? Which building is **shorter** than the CN Tower?



Example 1: The Burj Khalifa is the tallest building in the world

Example 2: The Willis Tower is shorter than the CN

- Complete the rules and examples
- When we compare two things, we add "_____" to one-syllable adjectives and the word "_____" after the adjective.
Example: wider, _____
- Note that adjectives ending in "y", replace the "y" for "i" and add "er".
Example: noisy – noisier, easy - _____
- Adjectives ending in consonant + vowel + consonant, double the last consonant.

For example: Big - Bigger

- Superlative adjectives take "_____" at the end. Example: widest, _____
- Place "the" before the adjective.

Building	City	Year	Height	Stories
1-Burj Khalifa	Dubai	2010	828m.	160
2-Taipei 101	Taipei	2004	508m.	101
3-World Financial Center	Shangai	2008	492m.	101
4-Petronas Tower	Kuala Lumpur	1998	252m.	88

1- Example: Taipei 101 is taller than the Petronas Tower.
