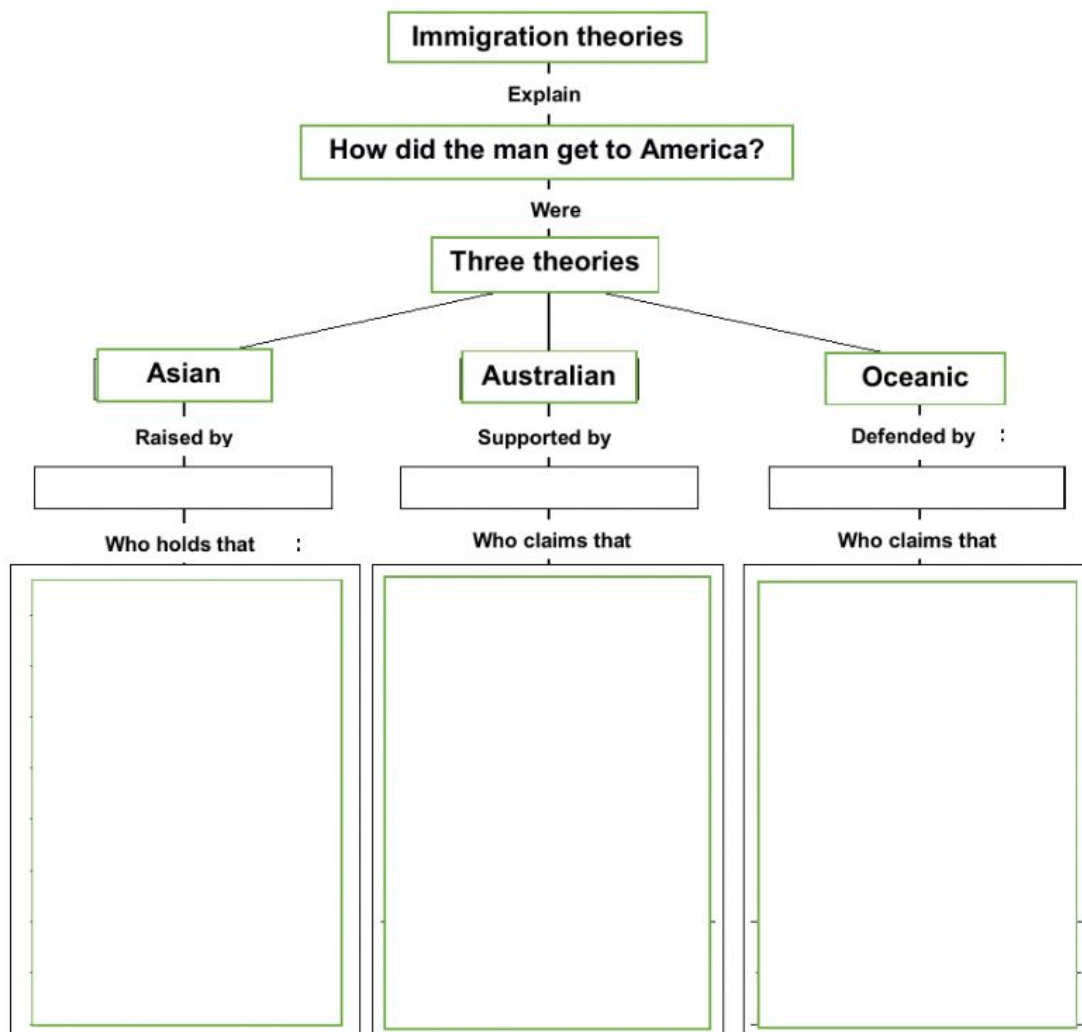
He claimed that the first settlers would have crossed the Bering Strait, in search of food.
