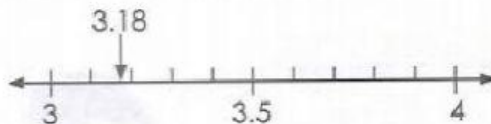

Rounding decimals to 1 decimal place

Let's Learn

- a) i) Round 3.18 meters to the nearest meter.

Picture
It



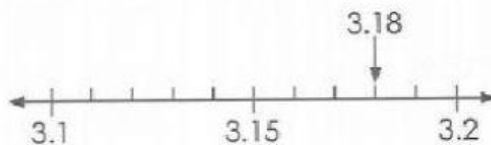
3.18 is less than halfway
between 3 and 4.



$$3.18 \approx 3$$

3.18 meters is 3 meters when rounded to the nearest meter.

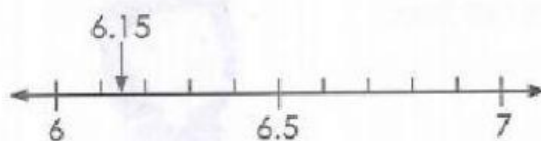
- ii) Round 3.18 meters to 1 decimal place.



$$3.18 \approx 3.2$$

3.18 meters is 3.2 meters when rounded to 1 decimal place.

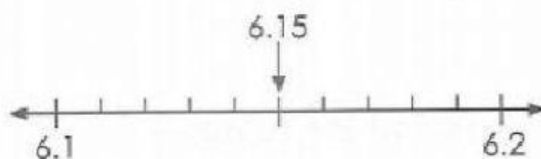
- b) i) Round 6.15 to the nearest whole number.



$$6.15 \approx 6$$

6.15 is 6 when rounded to the nearest whole number.

- ii) Round 6.15 to 1 decimal place.



$$6.15 \approx 6.2$$

6.15 is 6.2 when rounded to 1 decimal place.

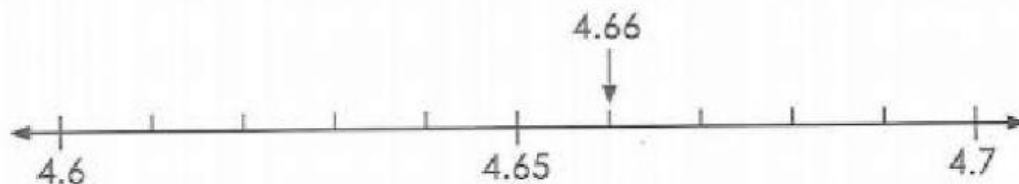

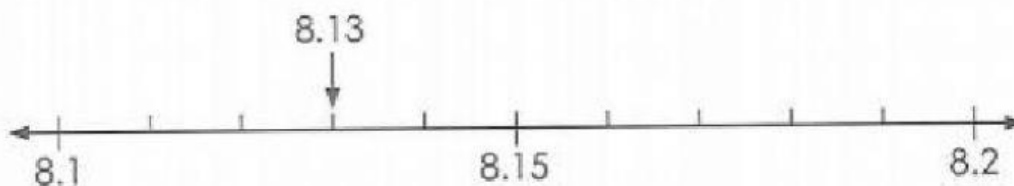
