

## Irregular Verbs – Past Tense

<b>be</b> – was/were	<b>choose</b> – chose	<b>fall</b> - fell
<b>become</b> – became	<b>come</b> – came	<b>feel</b> - felt
<b>begin</b> – began	<b>cut</b> – cut	<b>find</b> - found
<b>blow</b> – blew	<b>do</b> – did	<b>fly</b> - flew
<b>break</b> – broke	<b>drink</b> – drank	<b>forget</b> - forgot
<b>bring</b> – brought	<b>drive</b> – drove	<b>forgive</b> - forgave
<b>buy</b> – bought	<b>eat</b> – ate (8)	<b>get</b> – got

*In negative sentences and questions, you use the base form.*

*did not+ base form (example: didn't drink, didn't do)*

*Did ...? (example: Did you **bring**...? Did you **eat** lunch?)*
