RULE: Use the past simple to talk about finished actions in the past.

With regular verbs:

- We usually add ¹ _____ to the verb (e.g. *start – started / stay – stayed*).
- If the verb ends in -e (e.g. *use*), we add ² _____.
- If a short verb ends in consonant + vowel + consonant (e.g. *plan*), we double the ³ _____ and add -ed.
- We add -ed to verbs ending in vowel + -y (e.g. *stayed*).
- If the verb ends in consonant + -y (e.g. *try*), we change the -y to ⁴ _____ and add ⁵ _____.
