



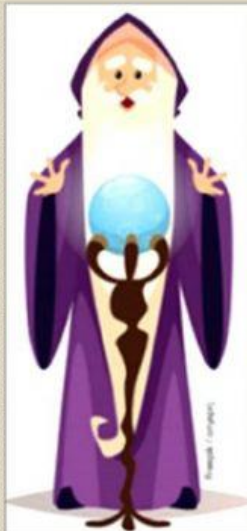

In Saint-Remy-de-Provence, France, in 1503 a child was born who later treated victims of the plague in France and Italy. Not much is known about his childhood. He studied Greek, Latin, Hebrew and Mathematics, and his grandfather taught him astrology. At age 14 he entered the University of Avignon to study medicine. This man became a world celebrity, not because of his medical skills, but because of his predictions.

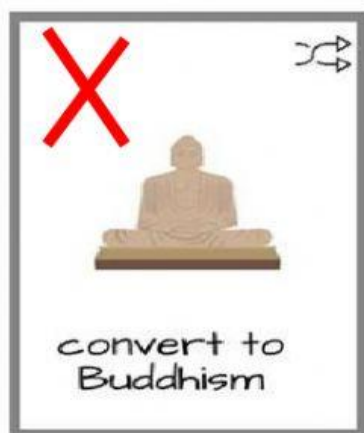
