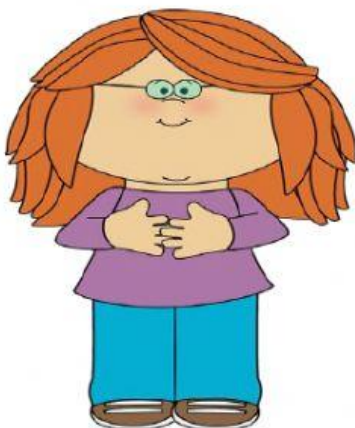


The Case of the Ugly Duckling
