

Science

Forces - PUSH and PULL

A force is a push or a pull on an object by another object or thing. A force can cause objects to speed up, slow down, or stay in one place. In other words, a force is what makes an object move. A push and a pull are opposite forces, meaning they move objects in different directions.



What is a push? A push is the force that moves an object **AWAY** from something.

For example you can;

- Push the grocery cart.
- Push the door closed.

Pull








What is a pull? A pull is the force of **BRINGING** an object **CLOSER**.

For example you can;

- Pull the curtains closed.
- Pull the door open.
