

PERSONAL AND IMPERSONAL CONSTRUCTIONS

The words **think, believe, say, report, know, expect, consider, understand, etc.** are used in the following passive patterns in personal and impersonal constructions.

Active: People **say** that he has lost his job.

Passive: a) **It is said** (that) he has lost his job. (impersonal construction)

b) **He is said to have lost** his job. (personal construction)

Active: People **know** that she **works** hard.

Passive: c) **It is known** that she **works** hard.

d) **She is known to work** hard.
