

JUNIORS' GRAMMAR - POSSESSIVE ADJECTIVES

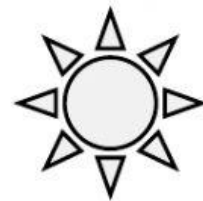
To show that something belongs to someone we say:
