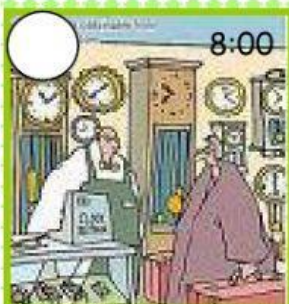
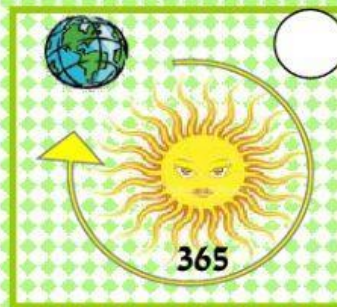


Present Simple / Present Progressive
