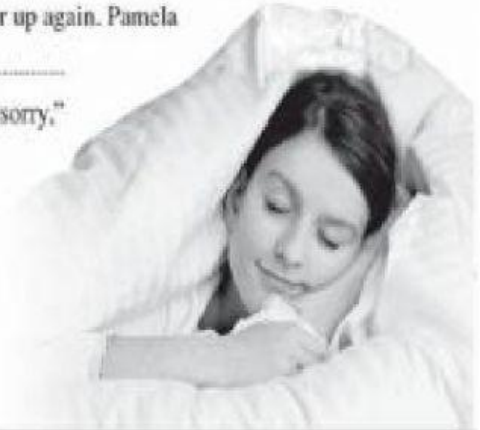


LATE AGAIN!
