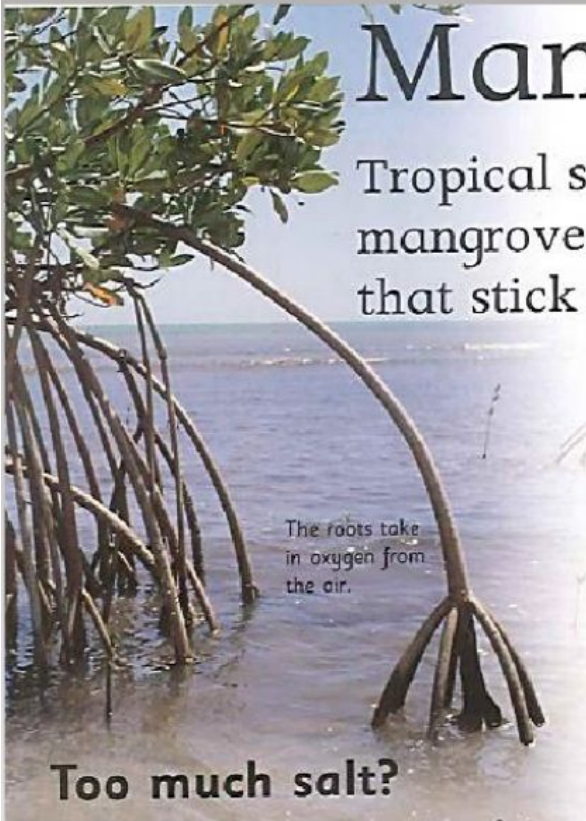

Long-tailed macaques, also known as crab-eating monkeys, are one of the larger inhabitants of Indonesian mangrove swamps.

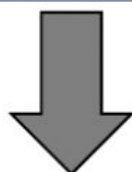
