





## 6.4 Moses Serves God

The **Passover** is a very important event. Compare the relationship between the Old Testament Passover lamb and Jesus, the sacrificial Lamb, by looking up each reference and writing the verse below it.

### *The Relationship Between the Passover and Jesus Christ*

The Passover	Jesus Christ, the Sacrificial Lamb
<p>1. The Passover lamb was a sacrifice.</p> 	<p>Hebrews 10:14</p>
<p>2. Leaven (yeast) represents the power of evil. Leaven was removed from the house, and unleavened bread was eaten.</p> 	<p>1 Corinthians 5:7</p>
<p>3. To identify with the suffering under Pharaoh, bitter herbs were eaten until tears came to the eyes.</p> 	<p>Galatians 5:1</p>



4. Use a red pencil or pen to put a dot three quarters up each of the two doorposts and in the middle of the lintel (above the door) to follow God's instructions to the Hebrews. Connect the dots on the doorposts, and draw a line straight down from the top dot to form a cross. Read Exodus 12:23, John 1:29, and Hebrews 9:22. Write a description of how the Passover was like Christ's death for your sins.
