Located in Central Africa, DRC is one of the most important countries in Africa for biodiversity conservation with a large number of spectacular species like the okapi, gorilla, bonobo, and Congo peacock along with over 400 other species of mammals, over 1,000 bird species, over 400 fish species, and over 10,000 species of plants. The country is home to the world's second-largest tropical forest and river basin, the Congo Basin. Deforestation remains an ongoing problem in the DRC. Slash-and-burn agriculture has destroyed many hectares of land, and many farmers lack the necessary education to employ long term agricultural practices. Due to the remote nature of the country, primary school enrollment is lower in rural areas than in urban areas. Education plays an important role in empowering the future conservationists of Africa. DRC is also a stronghold to the endangered gorilla, chimpanzees and elephants whose population has declined due to poaching and habitat loss.
