


## Questions with 'be' verb.

Write a question for each of these answers. Use a contraction if you can.

 **Word order**

- Subject, verb *They're American.*
- Verb, subject *Are they American?*
- Question, verb, subject *Where are they from?*

**Contractions with question words**

You can contract *is* after question words.

*What's her name?* = *What is her name?*  
*Where's he from?* = *Where is he from?*  
*How's Anna?* = *How is Anna?*  
*How old's Jan?* = *How old is Jan?*

Don't contract *is* in a question when the last word is a pronoun (*he, she, it, etc.*).

*How old is she?* NOT *How old's she?*  
*Where is he?* NOT *Where's he?*
