The ants are working.

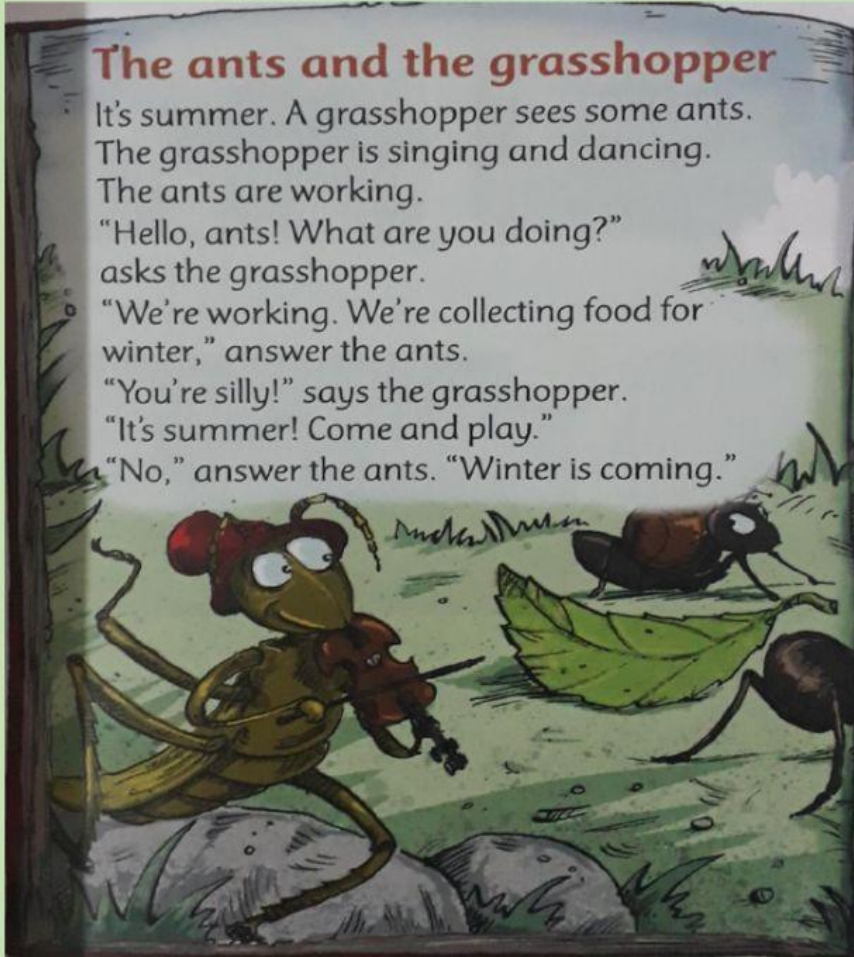
"Hello, ants! What are you doing?"
