Suffixes

Suffixes are a letter or group of letters added to the ending of words to change their meaning. Suffixes can be 1 or 2 letters such as 's' and 'ed' or many letters such as 'tion' or 'ment'

Today we will learn about the suffix '**ly**'

'**ly**' is used at the end of a word to tell **HOW** the action is done.

Examples: bravely, simply, honestly, gladly
