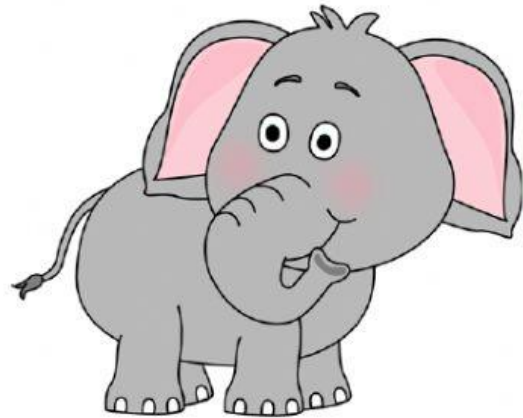


Elephant wants Friends *(Stories with a moral)*
