- A. Kuskovo was built between 1740 and 1780. The bulk of the construction was carried out in the 1750s. The eighteenth-century engravings and drawings give us an idea of the special layout of the estate. The axis more than three kilometers long serves to link up three component parts - the ground beyond the lake, the formal park, and the landscape park.
- B. Last year a staggering 65 million people had to leave their homes. 23 million of them had to leave their country (are refugees). Half of those - over 11 million - are children. It's the largest amount of people we know of that have had to leave their situation according to the United Nations Refugee Agency. And the children in particular haven't done anything to be in the situation they are in.
- C. The Golden State Warriors are headed to the NBA Championships after an epic comeback in the best of 7 series against the Oklahoma City Thunder. The Warriors were down three games to one. They had to win three games in a row under tremendous pressure. But the Golden State Warriors are proving to be no ordinary team.

Nelson never wore an eye-patch. He didn't wear anything at all over his damaged right eye. Though he had an eye-shade built into his hat to protect his good left eye from the sun. Nelson didn't have a blind eye. His right one was badly damaged at the siege in 1794. A French cannon ball threw sand and debris into it, but it still looked normal – so normal, in fact, he had difficulty convincing the Royal Navy he was eligible for a disability pension.

There is no contemporary portrait of Nelson wearing an eye-patch, and despite what most people recall having seen, the prominent column shows him without an eye-patch. It was only after his death that the eye-patch was used to add pathos to portraits. He used the damaged eye to his advantage. At the battle of Copenhagen, he ignored the recall signal issued by his superior.
