**AFFIRMATIVE FORM:** Susie ate a healthy breakfast this morning.

*subject + verb in the past + ....*

**NEGATIVE FORM:** Susie didn't eat a healthy breakfast this morning.

*subject + didn't + verb in the base form + ....*

**INTERROGATIVE FORM:** Did Susie eat a healthy breakfast this morning?

*Did + subject + verb in the base form + ....*
