<b>Unfinished actions that started in the past and continue to the present:</b> I have known my best friend since I was 10 years old.	<b>Finished action:</b> Yesterday I visited my grandmother.
<b>A finished action with a result in the present:</b> I have lost my book. I can't do the exercise.	<b>A finished action with no result in the present.</b> I lost my book at school.
