We use the **present continuous** tense when an action is happening now. It can also be used to show that an action is going to take place in the near future.

AFFIRMATIVE				
Subject	verb TO BE	verb -ING	complements	
I	am	wearing	a red cotton scarf	
She	is	reading	a book	
NEGATIVE				
Subject	verb TO BE (negative)	verb -ING	complements	
You	are not (aren't)	playing	basketball	
He	isn't	wearing	blue leggings	
INTERROGATIVE				
Verb TO BE	Subject	verb -ING	complements	Answers
Are	you	drinking	a coke?	Yes, I am No, I'm not
Is	she	wearing	jeans?	Yes, she is No, she isn't
