In the colony, there were differences between social classes so the rights of lower classes were not respected. Many _____ were brought by ship in inhuman conditions and many of them died during the voyage. Here, they were sold in the market.

Slaves were not free and their masters fed them and gave them clothes. Poorly dressed in jackets and trousers, they generally went barefoot or wore sandals made of skin. Sometimes, they got their masters' old clothes which looked ridiculous on them because they were too big or too long. They generally wore these clothes on Sundays.

The _____ belonged to another social class. They worked in the mines doing forced labour called *mita*. Besides, those who cultivated the land and raised cattle were under the control of a Spanish *encomendero*, who evangelized them. In this system, known as *encomienda*, the *encomenderos* could get products such as wheat, corn, chicken or labour from the natives they protected. Like slaves, the natives did not have rights. For example, they were not allowed to ride horses. They wore a loincloth or a long shirt. They were generally

barefoot or wore rudimentary shoes made of skin. Their hair was long and they wore accessories such as hairbands, necklaces and bracelets.

_____ were descendants of Spanish settlers in South America. Some of them were merchants; others were professionals or related to the Church. Their clothes were similar to those worn by the Spanish.

The _____ formed the upper social class. They regularly organized parties and meetings. Women made their own dresses out of European cloth and their slaves helped to sew them. They also wore petticoats, ornamental combs, and had fans and parasols to protect themselves from the sun. Men wore jackets, shirts, tight trousers, top hats and used canes.
